

DIRECTIONS TO CAMP

From west of the Cascades, take I-5 to Springfield, take McKenzie River exit 194A. At stoplight "T" intersection take left to stay on Hwy 126. Follow Hwy 126 for 50 miles to Hwy 242 (McKenzie Pass Scenic Route) and turn right. Continue on Hwy 242 about 7 miles to the sign for White Branch Youth Camp, entry on the right. From east of the Cascades: If Hwy 242 is closed, take Hwy 20 from Sisters towards Eugene. At Santiam Pass go left at the Y. Take left on Hwy 126 towards Eugene. Continue about 19 miles and turn left on Hwy 242 (McKenzie Pass Scenic Route). Continue on Hwy 242 about 7 miles to the sign for White Branch Youth Camp on the left, entry is on the right (gravel road at the large turn out). If Hwy 242 out of Sisters is open, the camp is about 30 miles at Milepost 62, entry on the left.

Please note GPS or navigation tools may take you to an incorrect location so please ensure you have given your group these directions to find us!!

Camp White Branch is a recreational facility and retreat center that specializes in Summer Camps, Outdoor School, and hosting events. The camp is between Eugene and Sisters in the Willamette National Forest making it easy to access from all directions. We offer year round rentals of our six cabins and dormitory, four RV sites, an Historic Lodge, and a Multi-Purpose Building making it the perfect place for retreats, conferences, reunions, and more!

WHAT WE DO

Our youth camps offer activities such as rafting, tie-dye, campfires, worship, guest speakers, and more, with the goal to provide youth with a safe and supportive environment to explore nature and their connection to God. Large external groups are also able to rent the facility during the summer weeks when camps aren't offered. For the rest of the year, the facilities can be utilized for winter retreats, outdoor school, sports camps, snow play for tubing, and as a recreational facility for group or event rental.

Six cabins with restrooms, sleeps 12 each

MEETING SPACES

The dining hall can be used for meals, meetings, or an area to gather. The large outdoor patio is available in summer. A rental kitchen is available for groups who want to cook for themselves.



Our historic lodge built in 1934, is a perfect venue for meetings and special events such as birthdays or anniversaries!

The multi-purpose building is a year round recreational facility with a capacity of 299 people. It has sport courts and a stage/chairs available on the first floor, and meeting spaces on the second floor. This building can be used for larger events.
